Materials Needed:

Yarn, Bulky weight (#5), approximately 100 yards
Needles, 16" circular in US size 10.5 (or a set of double pointed needles in the same size)
Needles, double pointed in US size 10
Darning or large eye yarn needle
Markers
Scissors

Abbreviations Used & Skills Needed:

CO: Cast on
Alt: Alternate
K: Knit
P: Purl
K2tog: Knit 2 together
St: Stitch
Rev St St: Reverse stockinette stitch
BO: Bind off
PM: Place Marker
Rnd: Round
SM: Slip marker
RM: Remove marker

The Headband is worked in multiples of 12 stitches plus 1 stitch

Using size 10.5 circular needles CO 85 sts

Being careful not to twist sts, work an Invisible Join.

PM after join. 84 sts on needle

Rnd 1 through 4: (K2, P2) around, SM

Rnd 5 K around, SM

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Rnd 6 Rev St St around, SM (In circular knitting Rev St St is simply the purl stitch)
Rnd 7 change to alt yarn color, continue Rev St St (purl each st) around, SM
Rnd 8 through 10: (K1, P2) around, SM
Rnd 11: Rev St St (purl each st) around, SM
Rnd 12 change to primary yarn color, continue Rev St St (purl each st) around, SM
Rnd 13 K around, SM
Rnd 14 through 17: (K2, P2) around, SM
At the end of Rnd 17 BO using Binding-Off in Pattern, this video link will help you better understand the process.
